<b>Exhibition</b>	For the first time Schaulager is staging an exhibition outside its building in Münchenstein being guest at Basel's most prestigious showroom of <i>bourgeois</i> daily life, the Haus zum Kirschgarten: The internationally celebrated artist Francis Alÿs will be integrating his famous collection of over 370 images of Saint Fabiola into this protestant, upper-class domestic environment to create a unique artistic intervention.
